That was "our" Bonnie. I describe her as "colorful". Lived life in a very happy way.

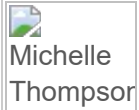
She loved her family very much! Each and every one of you. I am very sorry for your loss.

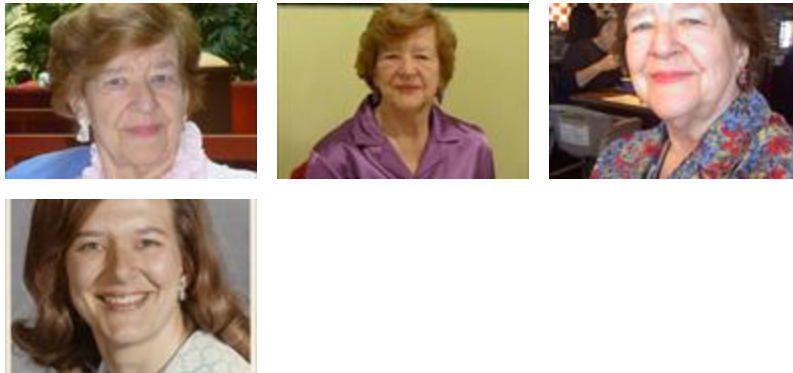
