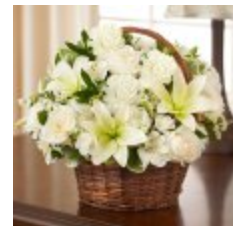

"Dude, check this out... Niel Peart has one of these." "One of these" was something you could hit with a drumstick, anything to do with percussions... chimes... bells... cow bells... HEY, Christopher Walken; you want more cow bell... CHUCK had more cow bell!!! Build it bigger and better!!!! If you could beat on it, bang on it, pound on it; Chuck wanted it within arm's reach of his seat... He would sit there for hours, in his gym shorts and shoes... sweating... jamin, with his head-phone on, stopping to drop into our conversation long enough to hit us with some wisdom... then back to the pounding. Several of us observed Chuck go from pounding and beating the drums... to playing and finding his way to rock the drums to RUSH (and only a couple other bands at the time), in a very short time. We were amazed at how focused, intent and driven he was, and, how skilled he had become. Boy... if this guy decided he would do something his pursuit became tenacious. The hair grew long and the rock-n-roll drummer of the century was emerging from an upstairs room, in the northeast heights. The other thing that was emerging from that upstairs bedroom, in the northeast heights, was the good

gentleman, the good brother, the good uncle, the good son, the good friend, the good gentle man; Charles V Sheldon, Jr., PhD!
