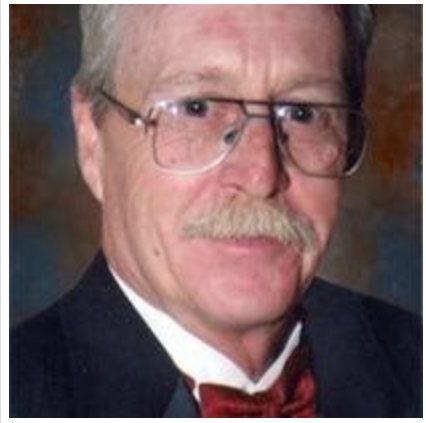




Don Frankhouse
