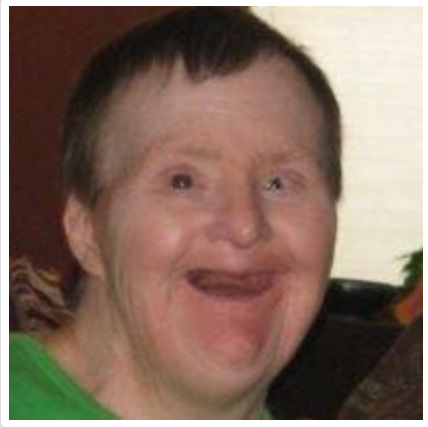




Gail Wight

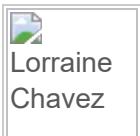
