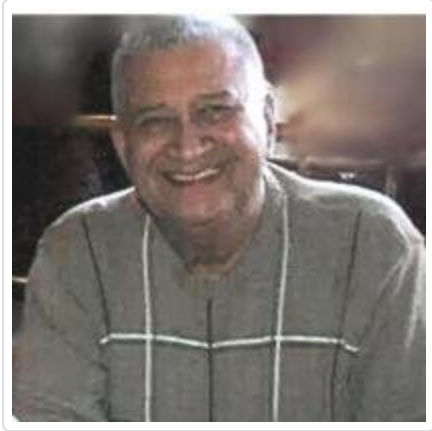




Gary Mo
