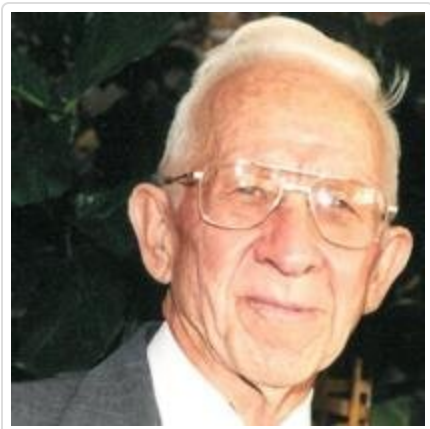




George W. Revels
