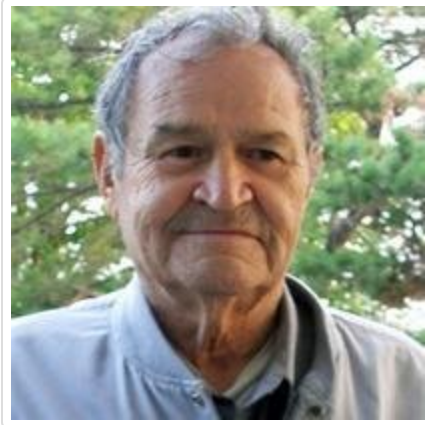




Gilbert Herrera
