May 25, 1933 - January 26, 2013

Long-time resident of Albuquerque passed away peacefully on Saturday, January 26, 2013 from complications of Parkinson's disease surrounded by loved ones. He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Marian E. Rodee; daughters, Katherine E. Rodee, Susannah E. Fedorowich and her husband Michael Fedorowich, and their expected baby. Howard is also survived by childhood best friend Darrell Meuthing and wife Joyce. He was preceded in death by his parents Howard and Margaret Rodee.
