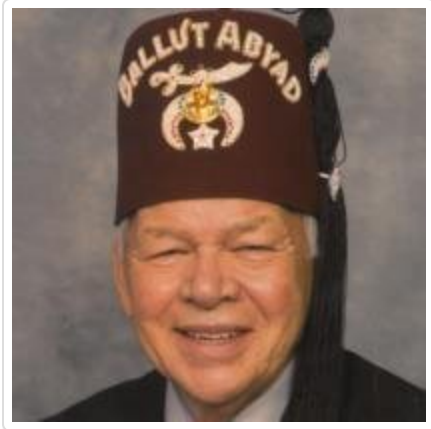




Jackie Wayne Bruce
