John N. Rhinehart, 84, of Albuquerque, New Mexico passed away on Friday, August 22, 2014. John was born on March 5, 1930 in Silver Creek, New York, where he lived for twelve years working on the family farm. At age thirteen he moved to Chicago, Illinois where he continued his schooling until joining the Navy, at which time he served in submarine duty during the Korean War. After the war, he returned to Chicago, where he met and married Rosemary Hanson (Yanahan). John and Rosemary moved their family to Albuquerque, New Mexico in 1956. John worked for many years in the aerospace industry as a jet engine mechanical designer at ACF, EG &G, and General Electric, until his retirement in 1992.
