



## Louis Wihl

May 11, 1922 - November 16, 2012

Louis (Louie) Joseph Wihl, United States Marine Corps: First Division, Fifth Regiment, WWII, age 90, was a resident of Albuquerque who retired from civil service at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Albuquerque. In retirement, Louie volunteered for the United States National Park and Forest Services for many years. Louie passed away on November 16, 2012. He was born on May 11, 1922, in Pinckneyville, Illinois, the youngest of eight children of his late parents, George and Louise Wihl. He was preceded by his brothers and sisters Eva, Charles, Ann, Sue, Helen, Francis and Denis.
