After retirement in 1981, Marlene was very active in several volunteer

organizations, primarily military oriented, including WAVES National and Navy League. She and David discovered the pleasure in traveling via cruise ships and driving around the U.S., visiting all 50 states. Upon Marlene's retirement, she was presented with a flag that flew over the capital on her birthday (Flag Day) in 1981.
