Mary E. Garfield, age 83, of Albuquerque went home to be with her Lord on February 21, 2014 after a brief illness. She was born on April 24, 1930 in Waverly, New York. She graduated from Waverly High School in 1948 and then attended the Robert Packer Hospital School of Nursing. She became a registered nurse in 1951. Mary worked at Robert Packer hospital for many years before moving to Albuquerque, NM where she worked for several doctors including Dr. A.J Tanny, Dr. Lucian (Red) Rice, and Dr. Steven Wolcott. She worked at the Presbyterian Urgent Care and was named the Presbyterian Hospital employee of the year and was loved by all her patients.
