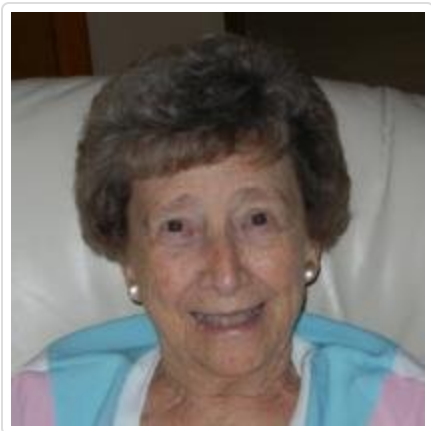




## Maxine Elsie Mueller
