Morris Nicholas Danielson, Jr., age 67, a resident of Albuquerque since 2012, passed away on January 27, 2014. He was born in Estherville, Iowa to Morris Sr. and Ella Danielson. He graduated from Graceland College in Lamoni, Iowa, earned his master's degree at Northwest Missouri State University and received his doctorate in education from the University of Northern Colorado. He had a long and successful career as an educator.
