



## Paul Lynn

May 11, 1928 - February 7, 2013

Age 84, of Albuquerque, NM passed away in his sleep while in hospice care on February 7, 2013 at The Cottages assisted living facility in Albuquerque, NM following a 5 ½ year battle with Alzheimer's disease.
