Philip (Phil) James Ulanowicz, age 70, died on July 24, 2015 at his home in Albuquerque, NM. He was born in Detroit, MI, in 1945 and was adopted by Genevieve and Carl Ulanowicz in 1946 of Grand Rapids, MI.
