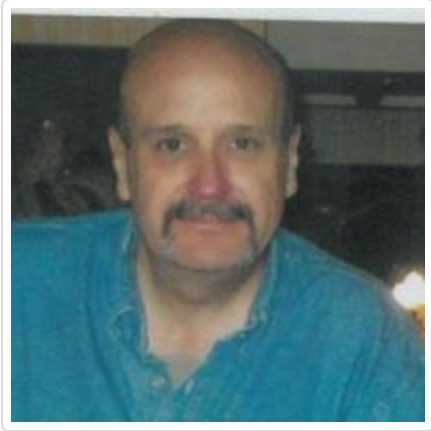




Ralph Eugene Luna
