Robert Blum Miller, 61, of Albuquerque, New Mexico, died peacefully at home on Monday April 21, 2014. Bob was a devoted son and brother and a loving husband and father. He was a tireless worker and will be missed by loving family friends and colleagues. He was born to the late Wallace and Dorothy Miller in St Paul Minnesota on September 30, 1952. He grew up in Columbus and Cleveland Ohio. He graduated from Charles F Brush High School in 1970 and he received an MBA from Cleveland State University in 1989.
