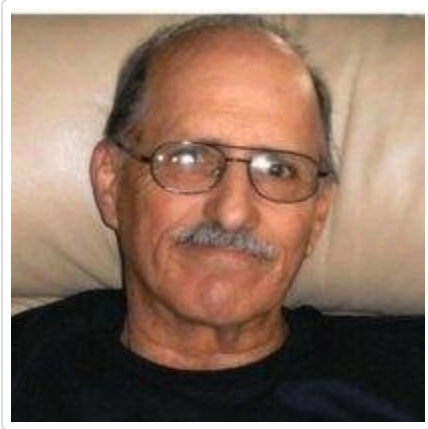




Robert Joe Sanchez
