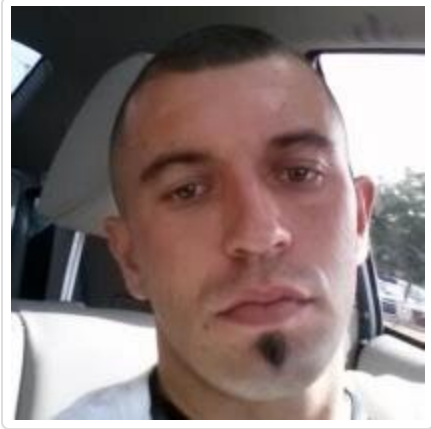




Ryan C. Chavez
