July 5, 1918 - March 23, 2014

Vada Radcliff, age 95, a resident of Albuquerque for 41 years, died Sunday, March 23, 2014. She is survived by her husband of 46 years, Dick Radcliff; three children, Cathy Parker and husband, Omer of Canyon, TX, Charley Radcliff of Burlington, WA and Shawn Radcliff and wife, Aliina of Aztec, NM; six grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; and numerous other relatives and friends. Vada was preceded in death by her parents, Jacob and Florence Leird. She was born in 1918 in Bellview, NM and after graduation from high school attended Highlands University. She married Joe Glennon and they ran a general merchandise store in Cuba, NM. She later owned and operated Vada Glennon Trading Post in Gallup, NM.
