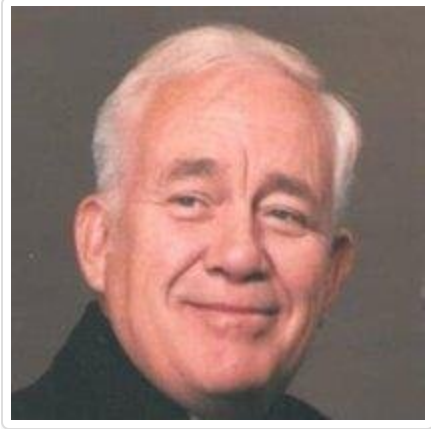




## Ward Dean Weber
