Warren Everette Perkins passed away Tuesday, August 20, 2013. He is survived by his son-in-law, Bruce E. Miller and wife, Lynda; and two grandchildren, Caleb B. Miller and Rebecca E. McIntyre and husband Trevor, all of Canada. He was preceded in death by his wife, Dixie, and daughter, Sue Ellen Miller. Mr. Perkins was an electronics engineer. He retired from National Cash Register Co. in Dayton, Ohio, and moved to Albuquerque in 1975. He was a graduate of Union College in Schenectady, New York, and was a member of Kappa Sigma Fraternity.
