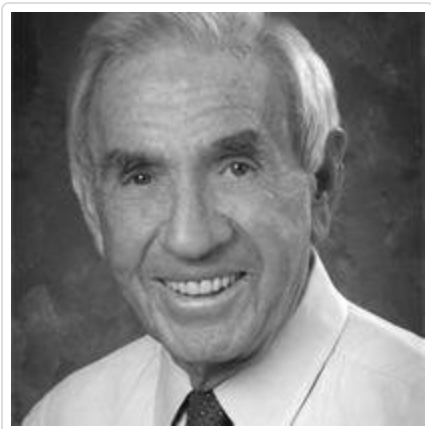




Weldon Hunter

March 18, 1928 - June 11, 2012

Age 84, a resident of Albuquerque, passed away on Monday, June 11, 2012, surrounded by his loving family.
